1. Genesis 3: 8–19

God tells sinful Adam that he has lost the life of Paradise and that his seed will bruise the serpent's head.

ALL: TPH 293 - O Come, O Come, Emmanuel

2. Genesis 22: 15–18

God promises to faithful Abraham that in his seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed.

Choir:(Chant ESV) - Song of Simeon

3. Isaiah 9: 2; 6–7

The prophet foretells the coming of the Savior.

ALL: TPH 306 - To Us a Child of Hope Is Born

4. Isaiah 11: 1–3a; 4a; 6–9

The peace that Christ will bring is foreshown.

Choir: (TPH 302) A shoot will spring from Jesse's stump

5. Luke 1: 26–35; 38

The angel Gabriel greets the Virgin Mary.

ALL: TPH 301 - Song of Mary

6. Luke 2: 1–7

Luke tells of the birth of Jesus.

Children, please come forward and join the choir!

Choir (v. 1) then ALL: TPH 315 - Silent night

Children, please return to your seats.

7. Luke 2: 8–16

The shepherds go to the manger.

Choir: TPH 310 - While Shepherds watched their Flocks

Choir: TPH 321 - Infant Holy, Infant Lowly

8. Matthew 2: 1–12

The wise men are led by the star to Jesus.

ALL: TPH 320 - As with Gladness Men of Old

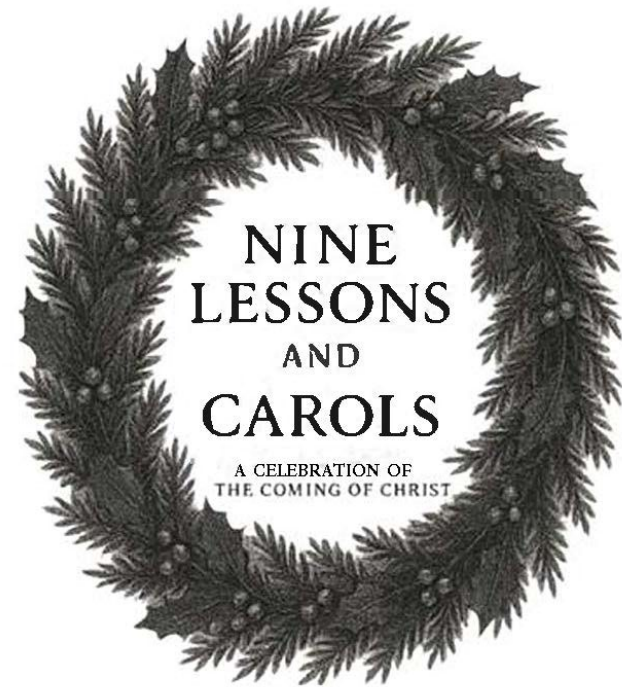
9. John 1: 1–14
